Please read the instructions for abstract submission carefully prior to submission. Abstracts must contain original scientific data collected by the author(s). All abstracts will be reviewed by the Abstract Committee. The Abstract Committee reserves the right to determine whether a submission is accepted as an oral or a poster, and its decision is final.


The abstract will be scheduled for oral presentation during the conference on a specified date and time. Please note that a blind review process will be conducted.






EMAS 2024 ABSTRACT SUBMISSION TIMELINE



Abstract Submission Process



General Information

- 1. Abstract submission types
 - Original research
 - Case report
- 2. Abstracts must be written in ENGLISH in no more than <u>350 words</u> (not including title, authors and affiliations).
- 3. Abstracts should contain work that has not been previously published. All studies relevant to the practice of emergency medicine are accepted.
- 4. All authors should agree with the content of the abstract and consent to be included as authors before submission. The abstract must include the complete first name, family name, affiliated institution and country. Do not include titles (Dr / Prof / Dato' etc.).

5. Abstract must be structured as follows:

- 6. A maximum of 3 abstract keywords are allowed. Do not include tables, images, figures and bibliographic references.
- 7. Use standard abbreviations only and spell out full at the first mention and follow with the abbreviation in parenthesis.
- 8. Use SI units for all measurements.
- 9. Authors must specify any relationship (employment, consulting, fees, conference fees, classes, commercial shares or copyright) they may have with any organization with direct or indirect financial interest in the topic or the materials dealt with within the presentation. If there were any conflicts of interest, authors must declare during submission.
- 10. Only abstracts judged to be of high quality and relevance will be accepted. The submission should be carefully proofread by the authors.
- 11. Failure to comply with these requirements will exclude the abstract from consideration.
- 12. Notification of acceptance will be sent to the submitting author with further instructions.
- 13. Only poster presentations are accepted. Shortlisted submissions will be invited for oral presentations during the conference. The corresponding author will be contacted via email for further details by <u>30 Jun 2024.</u>
- 14. Accepted abstracts are eligible for presentation after receiving full registration fee from the presenting author. If the registration fee of the presenter is not received by **15**th **July 2024**, the paper is assumed to have been withdrawn.

Authors Rules

- 1. Each abstract is permitted a maximum of 1 presenting author and 5 more contributing authors
- 2. Individuals may co-author multiple abstracts.

Presentation formats

The Abstract Committee reserves the right to determine whether a submission is accepted as an oral or a poster presentation. The decision made by the committee is final. The abstract or poster may be scheduled for presentation or display on any day during the conference.
